
During this season of celebration, we have much to celebrate together! Here are the latest Bible translation statistics for 2009.

Estimated world population in 2010—6.9 billion.

Estimated languages spoken—6,900

THE PAST— 2,479 language communities have some or all of the Bible in their mother tongue:

- 451 have an adequate Bible
- 1,185 have an adequate New Testament
- 843 have just portions of Scripture.



THE PRESENT—there are 1,990 active language programs. Wycliffe, working in partnership with language communities and local organizations are involved in 1,363 of these language programs affecting 936 million people.

✤ We celebrate those around the world who stand with us in this ministry today and those whose lives are changed through Bible Translation!

THE FUTURE—Remaining languages which have possible need of Bible translation—2,252 languages (around 353 million people. For comparison, the population of the United States is 308 million.)

The needs are still great. There is still much work to be done. Is God calling you to be part of telling about Our Savior's birth year round through Bible translation?

✤ We praise God for all those He is and will be bringing to do and support this work—until every tongue, tribe and nation has His story in their own language!

- In 2009, Wycliffe staff contributed to the completion of 2 Bibles, 25 New Testaments, and 26 New Testament revisions, affecting some 10 million people.
