"This generation could live to see all needed Bible translations started!"

"We live in a unique period of human history..."

Those were the words of Wycliffe USA's president Bob Cresson at a recent meeting for Wycliffe. No one has ever seen the needs of Bible translation drop, every other generation has seen the needs go up as new languages were found. The last official figure in November 2009 was 2, 252 languages still needing the Bible. The 2010 new official figure is 2078 languages representing around 340 million people who may have need for a Bible translation. Sometime in 2011, we expect that number will go below 2000! The pace of Bible translation is increasing and many of us will be alive to see all the remaining Bible translation needs met! We are

Wycliffe staff are currently involved in 1525 active language programs representing 2.6 billion people. Additional work is being undertaken by other organizations in 500 other languages.

Financial Update

Since our last newsletter, several individuals and a church have become partners with us in the Bible translation ministry. We are now only lacking \$200 per month! But because we are running short of 100% of our finances, we have begun receiving help from a fund which Wycliffe has for members who are low on their support for long periods of time. We can receive help from this fund only for one year. If our support is not at 100% by November 2011, we will be asked to step away from our current jobs here at JAARS and be required to devote all our time to support-raising until it is.

God is in control and we believe he will put it on the hearts of those he wants involved with us. We believe that Bible translation has eternal significance, which is why we have invested our lives in it. Would you pray and seek whether God would have you be a part of reaching those still waiting for His Word in their language. We know that if you seek God's will, He will reveal what he wants you to do.
