Let's Celebrate!

The arrival of the Scriptures is a reason to celebrate! Over the past twelve months, over 40 people groups have received the Bible in their language—that's a lot of celebrating!

When this momentous occasion occurs, a Bible dedication ceremony is typically organized by the people group to welcome God's Word. Many held a celebration event prior to the pandemic. For those in restricted access areas, however, public acknowledgement was not possible.

While COVID-19 has prevented mass community celebrations in recent months, the arrival of God's Word is no less important and we still rejoice! Here at the JAARS center, we recently held our own celebration. In keeping with social distancing, tables were set up outside in front of the aircraft hanger. One by one, missionaries placed available copies of the Scriptures and planted flags representing the countries of the people groups. For some groups, the Scriptures are being distributed via phone apps instead of print.

It opens with the Migabac of Papua New Guinea celebrating the arrival of God's Word, followed by the Romblomanon of the Philippines, the Samburu of Kenya, and the Gergiko of Chad. Scenes from our local event here at JAARS are interspersed through out the video. At the end, you will see a list of all of the translations being celebrated this year.



We rejoice that these language groups now have God's Word, but there's more work to do. Some groups only have portions of the Bible and need more; others still don't have any. Thanks so much for continuing to work with us to give people access to the Scriptures.


