Finance training in Dakar Senegal

In early June I, Mike, had the privilege of once again flying to Africa—this time to Dakar, Senegal—for a week of finance training with eight Wycliffe colleagues who are accountants from Chad, Côte d'Ivoire, Burkina Faso, Togo/Benin, and Mali. All of us had already attended the training in Nairobi, Kenya, back in March, but the French speaking participants requested additional time for hands-on practice, especially with the new accounting software we all have begun to use. I really enjoyed getting to use my French again.

It turned out to be a wonderful week. Alongside a few others, I was able to share new training sessions while also spending significant one-on-one time helping participants to address the specific challenges they faced. The fellowship was just as meaningful as the training itself. During meals, we shared food directly from a communal plate—a practice rich with cultural and social significance. Eating from one plate symbolizes unity and the bonds of family and friendship. For me, it was a beautiful reminder of the greater family we share as brothers and sisters in Christ.

Even though the training has ended, our time together has made us more comfortable reaching out to one another for help whenever questions arise.
